



**12th Annual Summer FUN Show
Orlando Convention Center
July 12-14, 2018**

Once again, this summer it was 95 degrees outside, but dealers were complaining that it was too cold inside. The show had 182 dealer booths including the U.S. Mint, all the grading services, Panning for Gold, Coins & Kids booth, exhibit area, educational programs, Wizard Supply, club section, budget section, and the YN & Scout programs on Saturday. Heritage Auctions had the multi-session auction selling \$6,058,260.

There were 65 Early Bird badges sold, 145 photo I.D.'s taken, and 4 club buses, sponsored by FUN, came in with a total of 146 collectors on board. The breakdown was, Greater Jacksonville with 34, Ocala with 45, Palm Beach with 45, and West Hernando with 22. Attendance was 2600 (not counting dealers, early birds, or staff) for the show. Free shuttle buses were running from the back parking lot to the show every 20 minutes.

FUN President Randy Campbell presented FUN Presidential Awards to Ed Abbott, Tony Bonaro, and Nancy Casey. The Coins & Kids booth had approximately 150 kids participate. The YN program had 16 attend and the Scouts had 14.

The 64th Annual FUN Convention will be January 10-13, 2019 in Orlando, in Halls WA1 & WA2, on the other end of the building from Summer FUN, next to the Rosen Center. The 13th Annual Summer FUN will be July 11-13, 2019 in Hall WE1, where it was this year. This is next to the Rosen Plaza.
